Prof. Som Nath Sachdeva, a distinguished alumnus of Kurukshetra University, holds a Doctorate in Civil Engineering under the guidance of experts from IIT Roorkee and NIT Kurukshetra. With over 35 years of experience in teaching, research, consultancy, and administration at NIT Kurukshetra, he has made significant contributions to the field of civil engineering. He was instrumental in starting the M.Tech program in Transportation Engineering in 2005 and established two advanced labs in the department. Prof. Sachdeva's teaching journey began at Punjab Engineering College, Chandigarh. A highly dedicated educator, he was recognized as the Best Teacher in his department at NIT Kurukshetra. Despite multiple prestigious job offers, including commissioned officer roles in Army Engineers and executive positions through UPSC, he chose academia. In research, he has supervised over 75 M.Tech and Ph.D. scholars and published more than 100 research papers, many in high-impact SCI journals. He has authored three books, six book chapters, and successfully completed several sponsored R & D projects. Prof. Sachdeva has received accolades, including Best Paper awards and a gold medal from the Indian Roads Congress and an international conference in the USA. A renowned consultant in highway engineering, he has been involved with numerous government and private projects, generating substantial revenue for his institute. As coordinator of the State Technical Agency under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana, he contributed to rural road projects worth over 2000 crores. Prof. Sachdeva has held key administrative roles, including Head of Department, Chief Warden, and NCC officer, achieving the rank of Captain. As Vice-Chancellor of Kurukshetra University (KUK), he spearheaded initiatives such as achieving NAAC A++ accreditation. Under his leadership, KUK has become the first university to implement NEP 2020, filed more than 60 patents, 02 incubation centres, 4 startups, running 08 skill enhancement centers in nearby villages. In addition to academics, Prof. Sachdeva has contributed to community development projects, including road widening, water supply schemes, and heritage development under the Krishna Circuit project. For his outstanding contributions, he has been honored by the Chief Minister and Governor of Haryana. A multifaceted personality, Prof. Sachdeva excels in academics, research, consultancy, and extracurricular activities, embodying a visionary leader with a profound impact on education and society.

In 2024, the college completed 56 glorious years of service to society. The aim of establishing this college was to make an easy access to higher education for girls of Shahabad and its adjoining villages in Haryana and of other states. The college is situated on Delhi-Chandigarh/Amritsar G.T. Road, between Pipli and Ambala Cantt. It is well connected with rail and road transport. Started as an Arts college, AKMV has now been transformed into a multi faculty Post Graduate College which has rendered meritorious service to the society in the field of women education. Now it is providing a healthy milieu for learning as it has carved a niche for itself in the competitive educational arena.

Our mission is to provide quality education to women from all strata of society and equip them with up to date knowledge of all fields. Our objective is to enthuse among the students the ideas of Indian Vedic Culture, to empower them and to prepare them to face the competitive world with courage, conviction and determination. It ensures social parity and gender sensitivity. The laurels achieved by our students in the field of academics, sports, cultural and co-curricular activities have brought this institution at par with the best Girls Colleges of Haryana.

COURSES

The College offers Post Graduate & Under Graduate courses in faculties of Arts, Science and Commerce. In Faculty of Arts different subjects are offered in course of B.A., namely, English, Hindi, Sanskrit, Punjabi, Economics, Political Science, History and practical subjects like Home Science, Music, Health and Physical Education. B.A. with restructured course Commercial Art Designing and Painting is also offered. In Science Faculty, B.Sc. in Medical, Non-Medical, Computer Science is offered. In Commerce Faculty, B. Com (General) and B.Com. (Computer Application) is offered; and in Faculty of Computer Application BCA is offered to students. Professional course of B.Sc. Fashion Designing is also offered to students. The college offers PG courses in M.Com, MA Hindi, MA Fine Arts and M. Sc Mathematics. Aligned with the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020, the College offers a range of career-oriented courses designed to enhance student' employability and holistic development. These include **Value-added courses** that provide additional industry-relevant skills, **Skill Enhancement Courses** focused on practical competencies in specific fields and **Ability Enhancement Courses** aimed at improving critical thinking, communication and analytical abilities.

COLLEGE CAMPUS

The college is spread over five acres of land and houses various departments in its three storied building. It includes an auditorium, girls hostel, air-conditioned seminar hall, fashion designing department, functional English lab, computer animation lab, state-of-the-art science labs, fine arts and home science labs, 6 air conditioned computer labs, air conditioned video sound recording lab, music room and history room. Out of 56 lecture rooms including labs, 22 classrooms and labs are equipped with projectors to aid modern teaching methodology. In addition to these, separate rooms are available for Women Cell, Placement Cell, NCC, NSS, Legal Literacy Cell and Medical Help Cell. Also, most of the subjects have individual Departmental Rooms.

GIRL'S HOSTEL

The college provides residential facility to the girl students only. The three storey building of the hostel, named 'Gayatri Bhawan', is well equipped with all facilities. Under the supervision of the hostel warden, the students from different parts of the country reside and share their cultural traits and maintain harmony. Various functions and events are organised in the residential compound that include Havan, fresher's party, farewell party and cultural fests like Lohri, Basant Panchmi, Janamashthmi, Guru Parv, Navratre, Shivratri, to name a few. The students who stay in the hostel participate in all activities of the college with utmost zeal and motivation. It nurtures traits of good personality and offers learning of various types of skills like leadership, cooperation, group sharing and caring. Hostel facility is also offered to the girl students of our sister institutions and surrounding educational institutions with the prior approval of the college authorities.

LIBRARY

The college has a well equipped state-of-the-art fully computerized and technically supported Central Library. It provides students with free internet access, an open-shelf system, and photocopying facilities to ensure they are equipped with essential learning tools to excel in life. During the last academic session, 140 books were added to the collection, bringing the total number of books in the library to 34,565. To ensure safety and efficient functioning, the library is equipped with eight CCTV cameras. The central library houses different sections for under graduate and post graduate students. Also, the students are allowed to carry their own books to the reading section which is especially earmarked for the purpose. Along with the Central Library facility, the college also has departmental libraries that support practical and subject-specific needs. Moreover, under the "Earn While You Learn" scheme, the library provides support to 04 students from economically weaker sections, reflecting the college's commitment to inclusive education.

STUDENT STRENGTH

During last academic session the college enrolled 1055 students in different faculties and value-added, skill enhancement and ability enhancement courses.

SCHOLARSHIPS

The college offers scholarship of different forms by Kurukshetra University, State Government, Management Committee, Honourable donors & other institutions to meritorious & economically weaker section students. • National Seminar: Innovative Trends of IPR in Digital Era

RUSA INFRASTRUCTURAL GRANT

RUSA Rashtriya Uchcharat Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA) is a centrally sponsored scheme launched by the Government of India in 2013 aimed at enhancing the quality of higher education in the country. It seeks to promote equity, access, and excellence in state higher educational institutions (HEIs) through funding and reforms. The scheme targets the improvement of infrastructure, faculty, and research in state universities and colleges, focusing on quality and accountability. RUSA is designed to improve the overall standard of higher education by providing strategic funding to higher education institutions, especially those that are run by state governments. It emphasizes the need for institutional restructuring, curriculum reforms, faculty development, and the promotion of innovative teaching practices. The primary objective of RUSA is to enhance access, equity, and quality in higher education across state institutions. It aims to reduce disparities by providing inclusive education, improve institutional governance, and promote academic and administrative reforms. RUSA seeks to upgrade infrastructure, encourage research and innovation, and create employable graduates by focusing on skill development and industry collaboration.

Arya Kanya Mahavidyalya became the Beneficiary of RUSA 2.0 Scheme in 2018 under which a grant of Rs. 2 Crore was sanctioned for the institution. Till date, the college has received an amount of Rs. 1.5 Crore in two installments. Out of which Rs. 1.4 Crore has been transferred to HPHC for New Construction and Renovation Work Project. New Construction Work which comprised 4 Classrooms, 2 Toilet Blocks, 1 Common Room and Renovation Work Auditorium, Toilet Blocks, 8 Classrooms, 3 Labs, Floor of Hostel, Administrative Building has been completed and balance of Rs. 10 Lacs has been approved to buy air conditioners through Gem Portal for auditorium and seminar room. Grant of Rs. 50 Lakh was granted for the institution for purchasing of new equipments in April 2024. This grant will be utilized in future for purchasing equipments whose approval was also received April 2023-2024.
